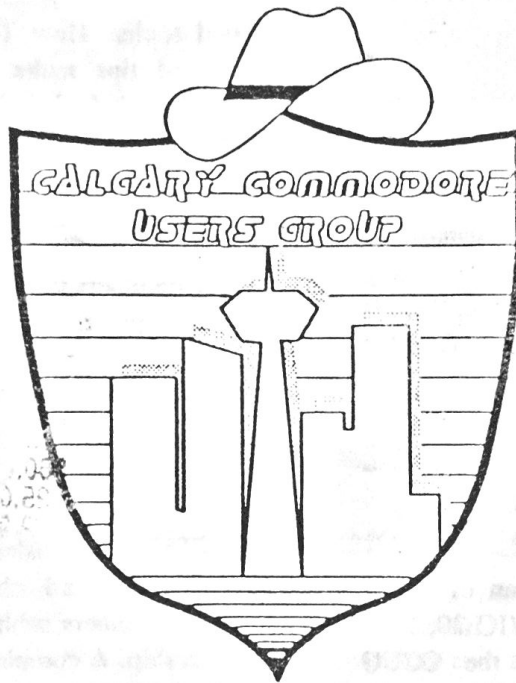

A wide variety of Public Domain Software is available free to all members by simply downloading. Access is available at either 300 or 1200 baud.

CCUG Programmers on Call provide assistance to members who are having problems using or writing programs. When someone is having trouble, there is usually someone available who can help find the answer.

MEMBERS GET GREAT PROGRAMS AT NOMINAL COST

CCUG members have a wide selection of Public Domain programs available for the VIC 20, C64, C128 and Amiga computers from the CCUG libraries for the respective machines. They can get a catalog of available programs at a very reasonable cost on disk from the librarian for the machine they

are using. The librarians for the C64, C128 and Amiga create a disk of the month for each meeting with a selection of the best currently available Public Domain entertainment, productivity and utility software

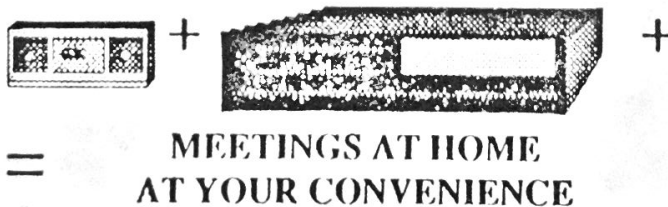
MEMBERS SAVE BIG ON PURCHASES
